Mr. Carlton Bailey, former Assistant Dean for Student Affairs with the Florida A&M University (FAMU) College of Pharmacy & Pharmaceutical Sciences, was recently honored by the College and the National Diamondback Pharmacy Alumni Council (NDPAC) as his lithographed likeness was unveiled in the College's Gallery of Distinction.

Mr. Bailey was one of the original inductees selected for the distinction in 1982, but he chose to delay posting of his plaque until after his separation from the College. He had been selected for that distinction because of his long history of student advocacy, and for his success in inspiring, recruiting, and mentoring young under-represented minority students seeking careers in pharmacy and the pharmaceutical sciences.

The presentation was made in February during the College's Annual Clinical Symposium in the presence of his family, friends, and fellow alumni. Carlton and his wife Barbara have two sons, Kevin and Shawn, and one grandson.
