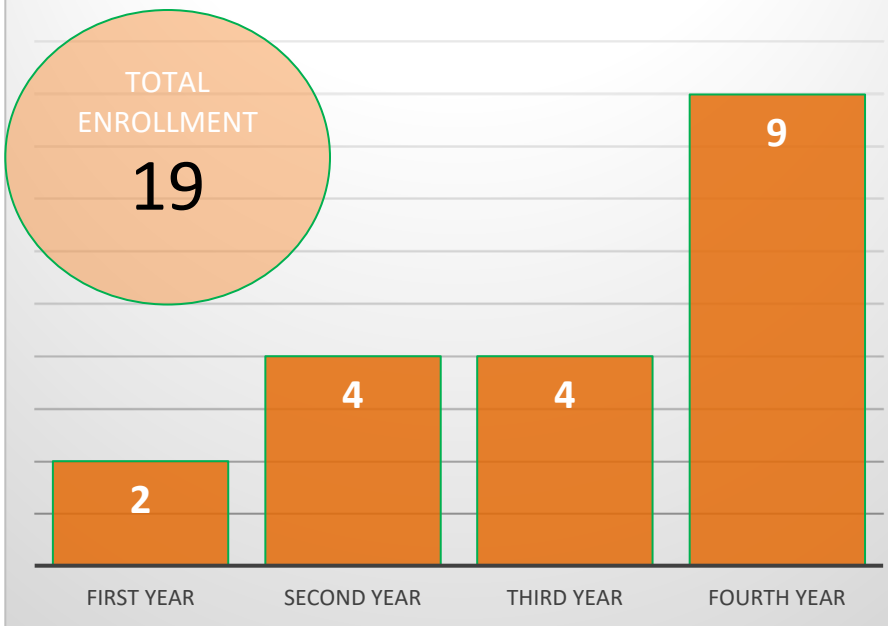

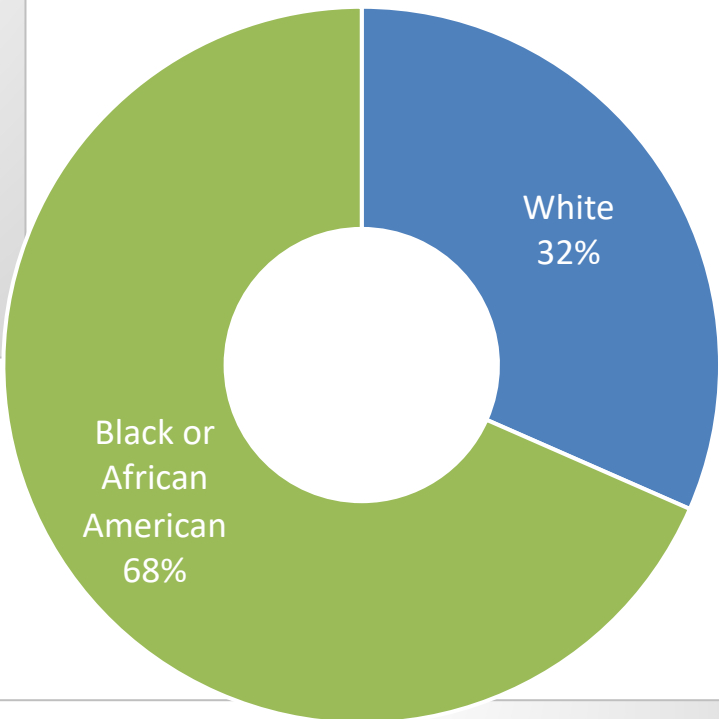

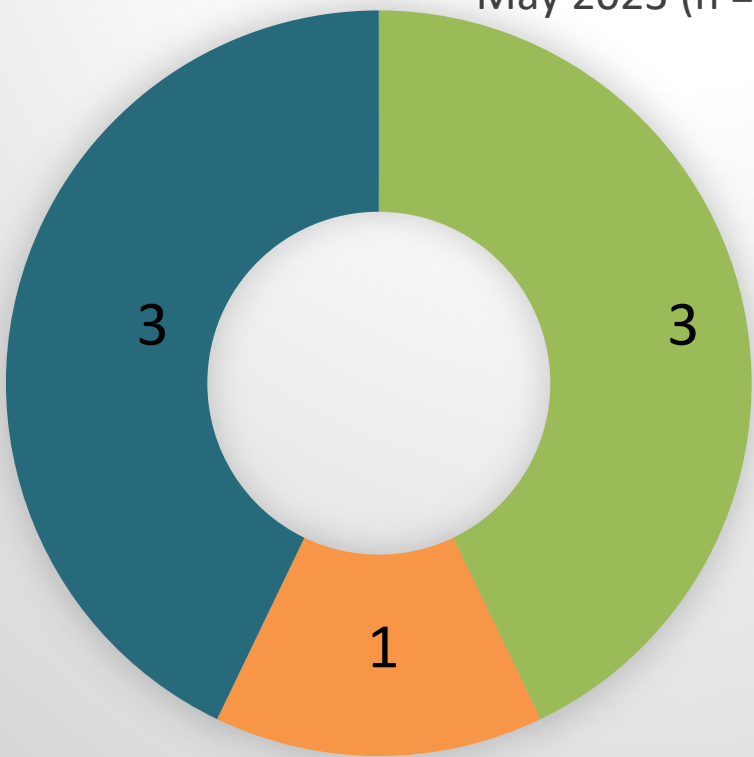


BSPS Student Profiles; Race/Ethnicity

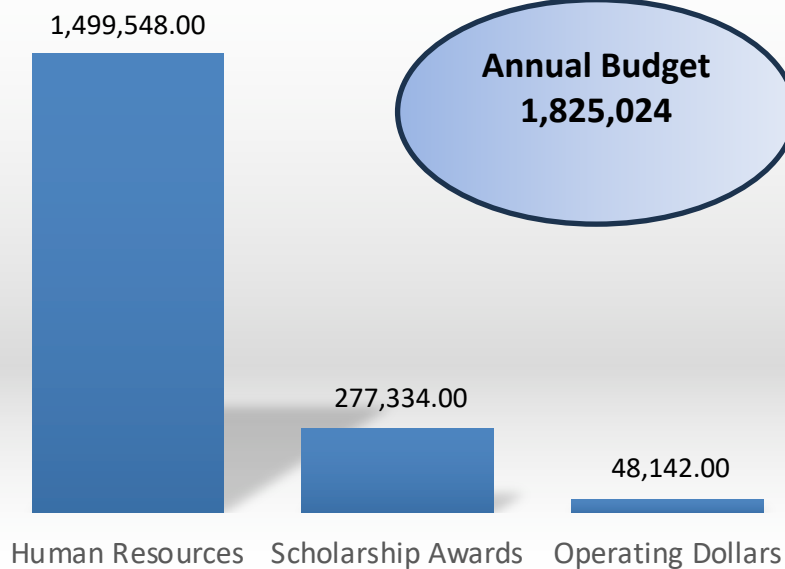

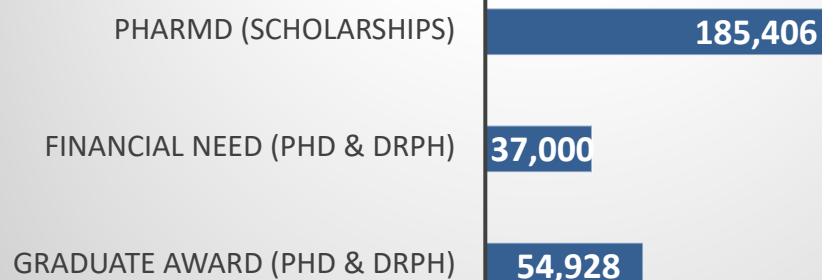

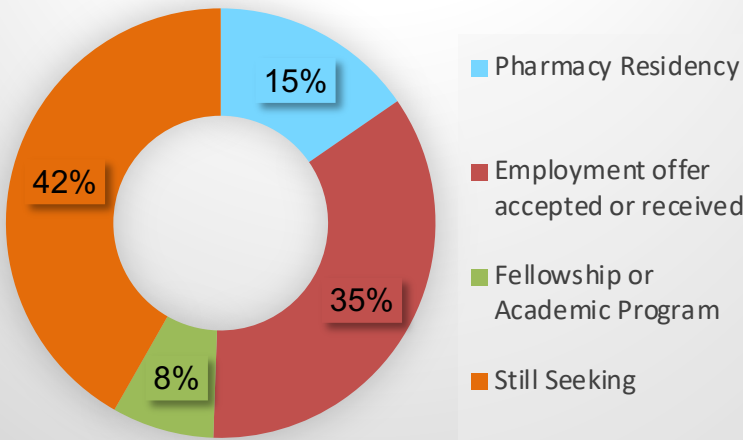

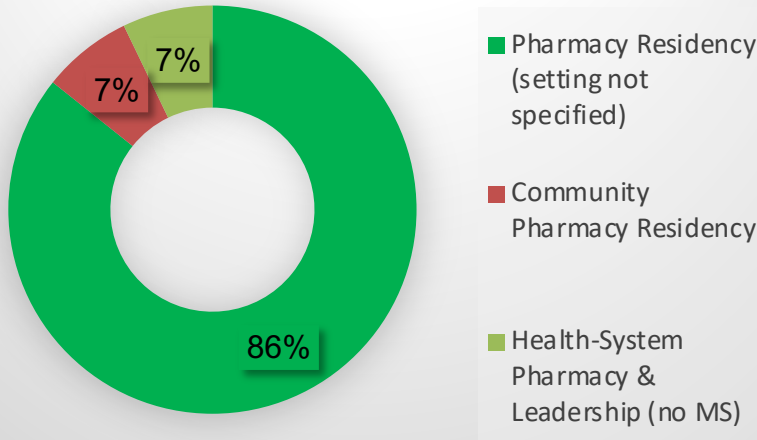

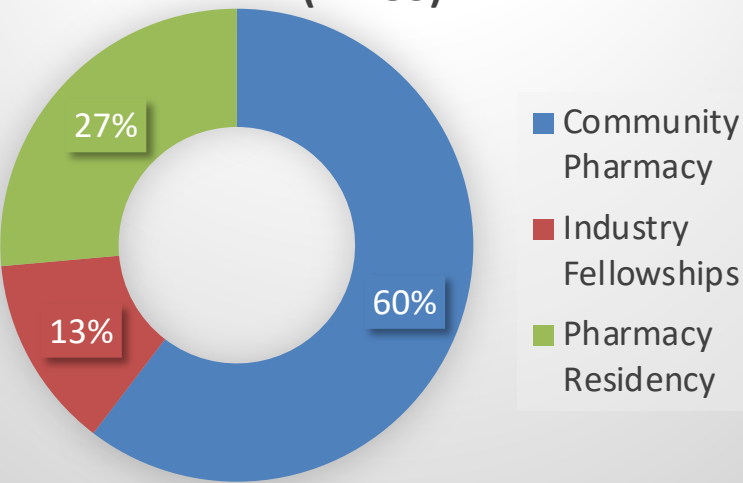
Class of 2023 Post-Graduation Outcomes (n = 91)



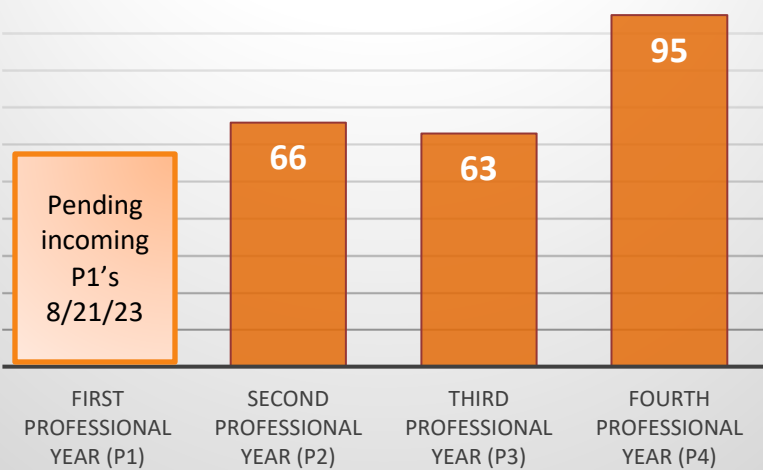
Residencies 2023: Practice Settings (n = 14)



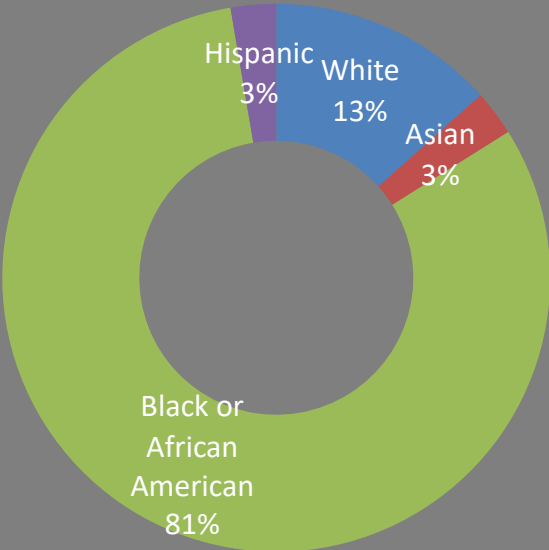
Employment in Practice Settings (n = 53)



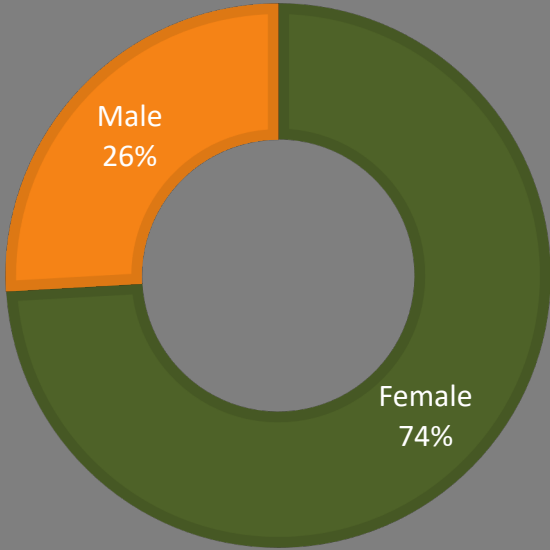

PHARMD STUDENT PROFILE GENDER JUNE 2023 (N = 224)

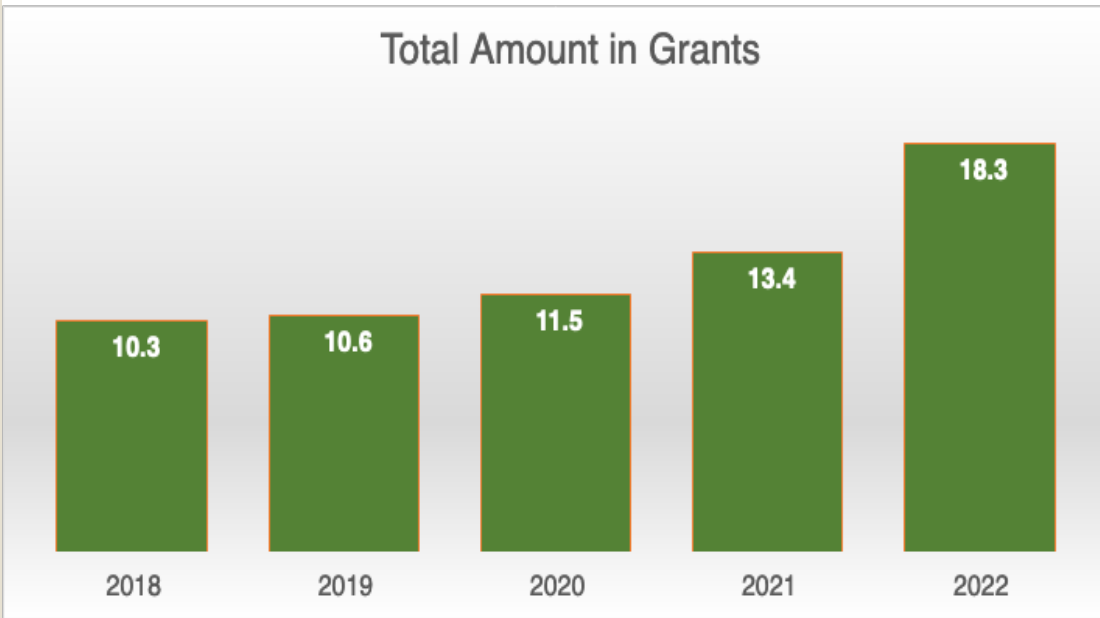

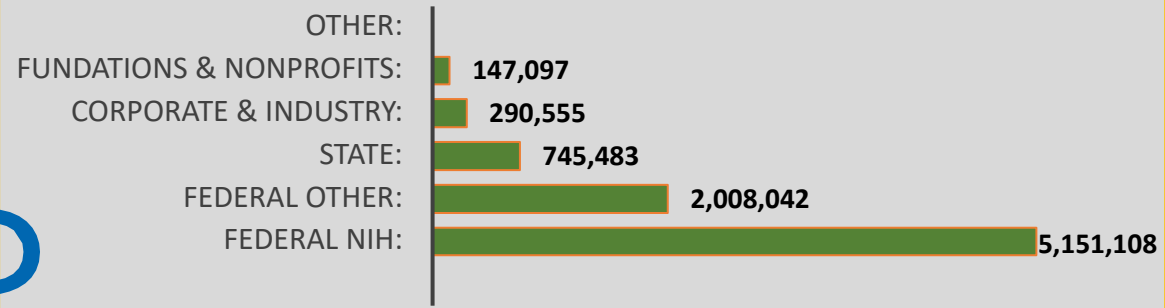

(AACCP Federal Fiscal Year 2022)

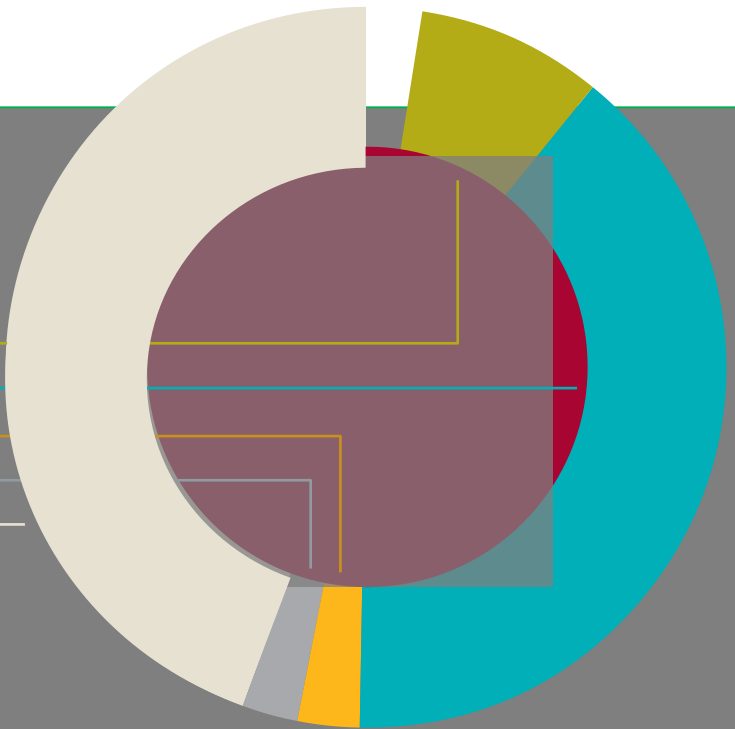

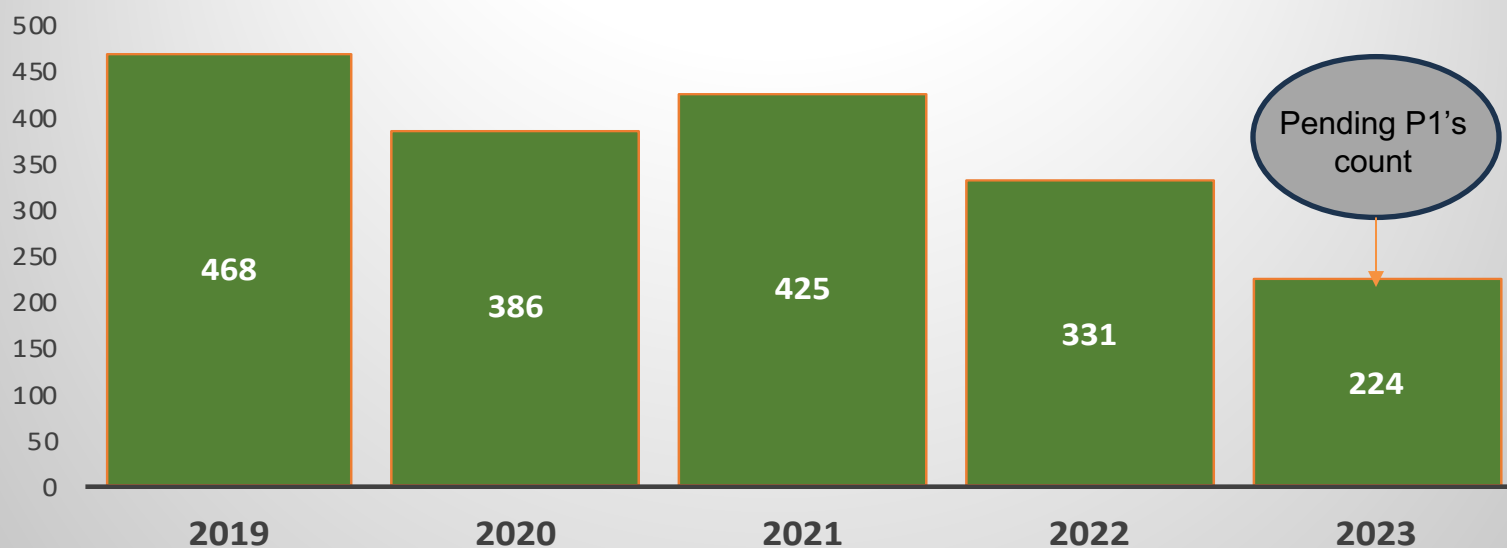
